

**RESOLUTION APPROVING INTERLOCAL  
AGREEMENT FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, The Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg, Mississippi, owns, operates and maintains ambulance services, rescue services, a hazmat response team, and a dive rescue team, through the Vicksburg Fire Department, for the citizens of the City of Vicksburg, Mississippi; and

**WHEREAS**, in the past, the City of Vicksburg has provided limited emergency services service outside of the corporate limits of the City of Vicksburg to the citizens of Warren County, Mississippi; and

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of Section 41-55-1, et. seq., Sec. 41-59-51 and Section 21-25-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg can contract with the Warren County Board of Supervisors to provide emergency services for the benefit of all citizens in Warren County, Mississippi, and

**WHEREAS**, The Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg, Mississippi, and the Warren County Board of Supervisors desire to enter into the attached Interlocal Agreement for the benefit of all citizens in the City of Vicksburg and Warren County.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved that George Flaggs, Jr., Mayor of the City of Vicksburg, be and is hereby authorized to execute for and on behalf of The Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg, Mississippi, said "Interlocal Governmental Agreement for Emergency Services," a copy of which is attached hereto, after approval from the Office of the Attorney General for the State of Mississippi.

**RESOLUTION APPROVING INTERLOCAL  
AGREEMENT FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, The Warren County Board of Supervisors and the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg, Mississippi have previously contracted to provide emergency services for the citizens living both within and outside the city limits of the City of Vicksburg, Mississippi, in Warren County, Mississippi, pursuant to an existing Interlocal Governmental Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of Section 41-55-1, et. seq., and Sec. 41-59-51 Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, the Board of Supervisors, Warren County, Mississippi can contract with the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg for the continued operation of emergency services for the benefit of all citizens in Warren County, Mississippi, and

**WHEREAS**, the Warren County Board of Supervisors and the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg, desire to enter into an Interlocal Governmental Agreement for the continued operation of ambulance and rescue service by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg, Mississippi, and for said service, Warren County will provide funds in accordance with the Agreement, to be computed and billed in quarterly installments as set forth in said Interlocal Governmental Agreement.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Warren County Board of Supervisors that the said Board, for and on behalf of Warren County, Mississippi, in accordance with the provisions of Section 41-55-1, et. seq., and Section 41-59-51 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, enter into an Interlocal Governmental Agreement with the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg, Mississippi for emergency services in accordance with the Interlocal Governmental Agreement attached hereto and made a part hereof as copied in full herein; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved that Jeff Holland, as President of the Warren County Board of Supervisors , be and is hereby authorized to execute for and on behalf of Warren County Board of Supervisors such Agreement upon approval from the Office of the Attorney General for the State of Mississippi.

**INTERLOCAL GOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT  
FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, The Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg, Mississippi, (hereinafter “City”), owns, operates and maintains emergency services, including a public ambulance service, rescue service, a hazmat team and dive team, for the benefit of the citizens of the City of Vicksburg; and

**WHEREAS**, outside of the City Limits, all of these services are not available by a privately run ambulance service responding to emergencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg, representing the City of Vicksburg and the Warren County Board of Supervisors, representing Warren County, Mississippi, (hereinafter “County”), have determined that it would be in the best interest of all of the citizens of Warren County, that the City and County enter into a contractual agreement, pursuant to the provisions of Section 41-55-1, et. seq., 41-59-51 and 21-25-5 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, for the City to provide the County with the above stated emergency services for all citizens of Warren County living outside the municipal limits of the City of Vicksburg, while providing the same services to the citizens of Warren County living within the municipal limits of the City of Vicksburg; and

**WHEREAS**, the City and County have contracted previously with each other regarding the provisions of public ambulance service and other emergency services for the citizens of Warren County who reside outside the municipal limits of the City of Vicksburg; and

**WHEREAS**, the City and County last contracted for such services in 2018 which will end on September 30, 2020, and the City and County desire to enter into a new Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City and County are of the opinion that it would be in the best interest of all of the citizens of Warren County that the parties contract with each other for the provision of

emergency services for all citizens of Warren County.

**IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The County, pursuant to the authority of Section 41-55-1, et seq., and Section 41-59-51 Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, shall pay to the City an annual lump sum fee of \$280,000.00 to provide rescue service, hazmat team and dive team services to defray the expense of emergency rescue services for all citizens of Warren County who reside outside the municipal limits of the City of Vicksburg for the fiscal years beginning October 1, 2020, and ending September 30, 2022. The annual payment for this service be made in four (4) equal installments and paid with the ambulance bills each quarter. This amount is agreed upon by the parties regardless of the number of responses or calls for service for rescue outside of the city limits.
2. The County, pursuant to the authority of Section 41-55-1, et seq, and Section 41-59-51 Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, shall pay to the City \$400.00 per ambulance response to the County from October 1, 2020, through September 30, 2022.
3. “County ambulance run or response” is defined as each dispatched ambulance that proceeds en route to the call in response and that originates outside of the city limits, but within Warren County, except for those responses that originate from Merit Health River Region Medical Center, or any successor. A response includes those E-911 emergency dispatches that are en route and subsequently cancelled. It does not include non-emergency transfers.
4. The City shall secure and maintain adequate equipment and a trained staff to furnish emergency services to all citizens of Warren County. The purchase, maintenance and

operation of the vehicles and the equipment and the employment of trained staff shall be the sole responsibility of the City. All equipment shall remain the property of the City.

5. The County shall pay to the City the “per ambulance run” fee to be billed by the City and the one-fourth payment of the lump sum for rescue services, according to the following schedule:

FY 2021

- a. First Quarter Installment: January 30, 2021 for October 1, 2020 – December 31, 2020
- b. Second Quarter Installment: April 30, 2021 for January 1, 2021 – March 31, 2021
- c. Third Quarter Installment: July 30, 2021 for April 1, 2021 – June 30, 2021
- d. Fourth Quarter Installment: October 30, 2021 for July 1, 2021 – September 30, 2021

FY2022

- a. First Quarter Installment: January 30, 2022 for October 1, 2021 – December 31, 2021
- b. Second Quarter Installment: April 30, 2022 for January 1, 2022 – March 31, 2022
- c. Third Quarter Installment: July 30, 2022 for April 1, 2022– June 30, 2022
- d. Fourth Quarter Installment: October 30, 2022 for July 1, 2022 – September 30, 2022

6. Either party may terminate this agreement by giving the other party ninety (90) days written notice of termination to the other party. Said notice shall be approved by the Board of the terminating party and then delivered to the Mayor, if to the City of Vicksburg, or to the President of the Board of Supervisors, if to the County.

7. This Agreement shall be in force and effect from and after its approval by the Attorney General, pursuant to Section 17-13-11 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, and the filing of the Agreement with the Chancery Clerk of Warren County, Mississippi and Secretary

of State of Mississippi.
