TEMPORARY LODGING

Mississippi Emergency Management Agency is entering into an agreement with the American Red Cross to assist in temporarily lodging displaced residents from the March 24, 2023, deadly tornadoes. Under this agreement, the American Red Cross will place eligible disaster survivors into hotel or motel rooms, and provide meals for those individuals and families for up to six months based on need.

To qualify for this program, survivors must register first with FEMA at DisasterAssistance.gov or call 800-621-3362.

Displaced storm survivors who need temporary lodging under this program should call: 1-800-RedCross. (1-800-733-2767).

GOVERNMENT FACILITIES

While several government offices in Sharkey County remain closed due to significant building damages, some have temporarily reopened to serve our community.

- **Sharkey County Courthouse:** Sharkey County Chancery/Circuit Court Offices and Sharkey County Justice/Sanitation Offices are operating out of a facility in the Courthouse parking lot.
- **Tax Assessors' Office:** Closed until safe ingress and egress can be established.
- **City Hall:** Operating out of the Rolling Fork Civic Center (former Armory), 19719 US-61. Call 662-873-2814 for assistance.
- **Issaquena/ Sharkey Library:** Closed due to damages.
- **Issaquena/ Sharkey Health Department:** Open for operation.
- **Rolling Fork Police Department:** Office is temporarily closed.
- **Rolling Fork Public Works:** Office is temporarily closed due to significant damage.
- **City Recreation Center:** Closed due to significant damage.
- **Rolling Fork Volunteer Fire Department:** Operating out of a temporary facility.
- **US Post Office:** Functioning, and we are working on an improved temporary solution.
- **South Delta Schools:** A soft start for all students K-12 will be 4/14/23 at the South Delta Middle School. For questions, please call 662-873-4302.
